AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONTRACTORS TO BE LISTED Town of Newburgh WITH THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH

BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1: Contractors working in the jurisdiction of the Town of Newburgh must be listed by the Town of Newburgh Zoning Administrator.

SECTION 2: In order to obtain a listing the following must be provided:

A. A completed Contractor Listing Application, containing the following information:

- 1. Name
- 2. Address
- 3. Phone Number
- 4. Legal business status of the listed contractor (sole proprietor, partnership, corporation)
- 5. Individuals authorized to secure permits under this listing Information shall be updated annually.
- B. An annual fee in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) to cover the cost of processing the application and administering this ordinance.
- C. Proof of a worker's compensation, public liability, and property damage insurance policy insuring the listed contractor and naming the Town of Newburgh as "additional insured" in an amount of not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). A fifteen (15) day notification of cancellation is required.
- D. Property Owners' Exception: A private property owner shall be able to obtain a permit to perform work in or about his/her own property for a new or remodeled building or structure without the listing requirements contained herein. Any contractors hired by a property owner shall be listed by the Town of Newburgh Zoning Administrator. All work shall be permitted and inspected the same as other permits and shall adhere to all other state and local requirements.

SECTION 3: The Zoning Administrator may issue a Stop Work Order if construction is occurring in violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Any person, firm, or corporation which shall be found to be guilty of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a civil penalty of not

less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for each offense. Each day during which said violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
